Reciprocity

POLICY:

The University of California campuses offer reciprocity to faculty and staff for parking permits. Each campus has a unique set of circumstances relating to various parking issues (parking spaces available, rates, access by gate, kiosks, specifically designated lots, etc.). Because of these differences, the permit holder should contact the campus Parking Office in advance to arrange for reciprocal parking.

Reciprocity among the UC campuses is for the purpose of expediting the university business for the faculty or staff member at the host campus and is valid for no more than five consecutive days. If a parking permit is needed for a longer period of time, the user must then purchase the appropriate permit.

Student parking permits do not have reciprocity. Students who visit other UC campuses must purchase a permit at the host campus according to the regulations and eligibility set forth by that campus.

PROCEDURE:

To obtain a permit for the specific campus visited; the staff or faculty member should visit the campus' Information/Parking Kiosk or Parking Sales Office upon arrival. The user will then be issued a permit at no charge and given the necessary parking and access information.
